A review of the Revised Continued Professional Learning (CPL) and mandatory Sexual Abuse Prevention Program with Melanie Dixon, RECE.

She is a collaborative leader with varied experience in the early years sector, including licensed child care, family resource programs, post-secondary education, government and professional regulation.
